

I.V. Sedation Instructions for Children

Pre-Op Instructions for Patient and/or Responsible Adult

Must be accompanied by a responsible adult

Responsible adult driver needed to and from the office

No solid food, milk, or liquids after 12:00 midnight

No chance of pregnancy

Do not wear contact lenses, jewelry or watches

Wear comfortable, loose clothing

Change of clothes for children if not wearing a diaper or training pants

Post-Op Instructions for Patient and/or Responsible Adult

Take all regular or prescribed medications as outlined by Physician or Dentist

No alcohol for 24 hours post-surgery

No driving for 24 hours post-surgery

Drink plenty of clear liquids

Must have responsible adult drive patient home and observe recovery

You may resume normal activity the following day

I.V. Sedation is helpful for the dental patient. Most patients experience a less stressful appointment and tend to not remember the details.
